

Annual General Meeting

BNW's AGM will be held on Thursday 19th May 2022, in the Parish Hall of St John's Church, Broadstone, starting at 7.30pm. The purpose of the AGM will be to approve the minutes of the previous AGM, review the Watch's activities for the past year, approve the financial accounts, approve a change to the constitution, elect the committee and respond to any questions or comments from members. - The following motion will be raised at the AGM, as an amendment to clause 8 (Meetings) of the constitution: "Each member of the Committee shall have one vote only. Motions shall be decided by a simple majority of those present and voting. In the event of a tied vote, motions shall be deemed to be lost".
- As always, we'd be pleased to hear from anyone interested in taking on a more active role within the Watch. Our committee currently consists of seven elected officers (Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Membership Secretary, Media Officer, Treasurer and Editor) and up to eight elected Coordinators. Most current committee members are prepared to stand for re-election, and anyone else interested in standing for any of these roles should notify the Secretary by 21st April 2022. Members attending the AGM will vote in the new Committee.
- Any questions for the AGM should be sent to the Secretary by 12th May 2022 so we can ensure a full response is provided and hold the meeting to time.
